



Security Risks

- Kidnap (for Ransom)
- Terrorism
- Threats / Stalking
- Violence / Physical Abuse





Safety Risks

- Natural disasters
- Accidents
- Health / Sickness



Business Risks





- Information leakage
- Reputational damage
- Media coverage
- Public opinion





- Drop out Vital Functions
 - e.g. Due to fatal accidents





Risk Assessments



- General risks
 - Operational
 - Office, Business, Transport
 - Environmental
 - Media, public opinion, business environment
- Events
 - Public (General Meeting, Conference)
 - Internal/Company (Social events, Meetings)
 - Sponsoring (Sports, Cultural)
- Travel

- Indirect threats





Less is More


- Intrusion to the executives independence


