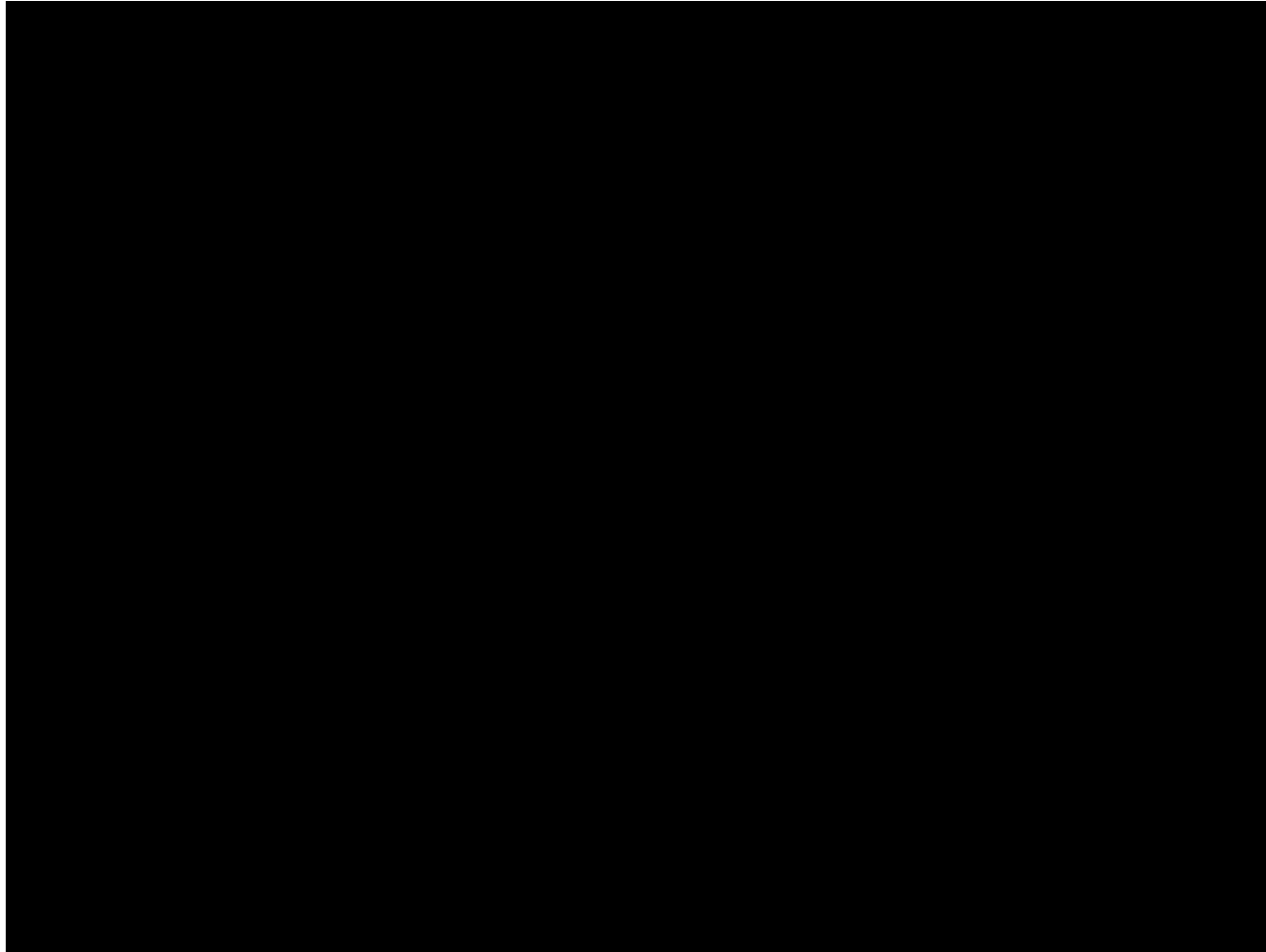

- Drop out Vital Functions
 - e.g. Due to fatal accidents

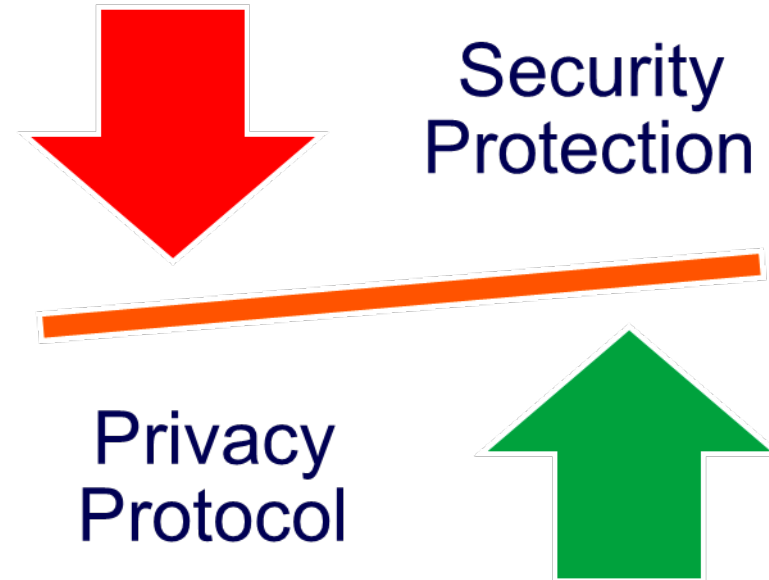
- Direct threats

Walk a High Wire



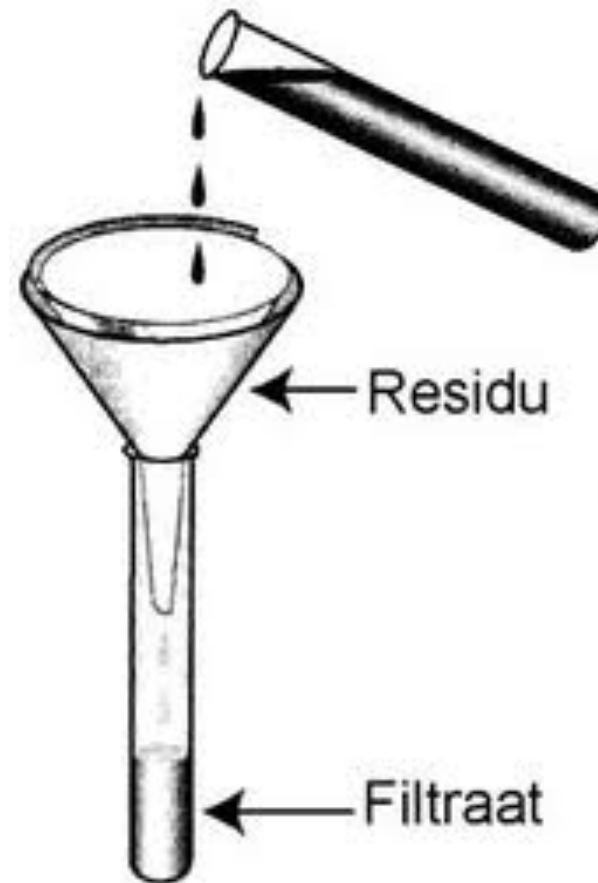
Less is More

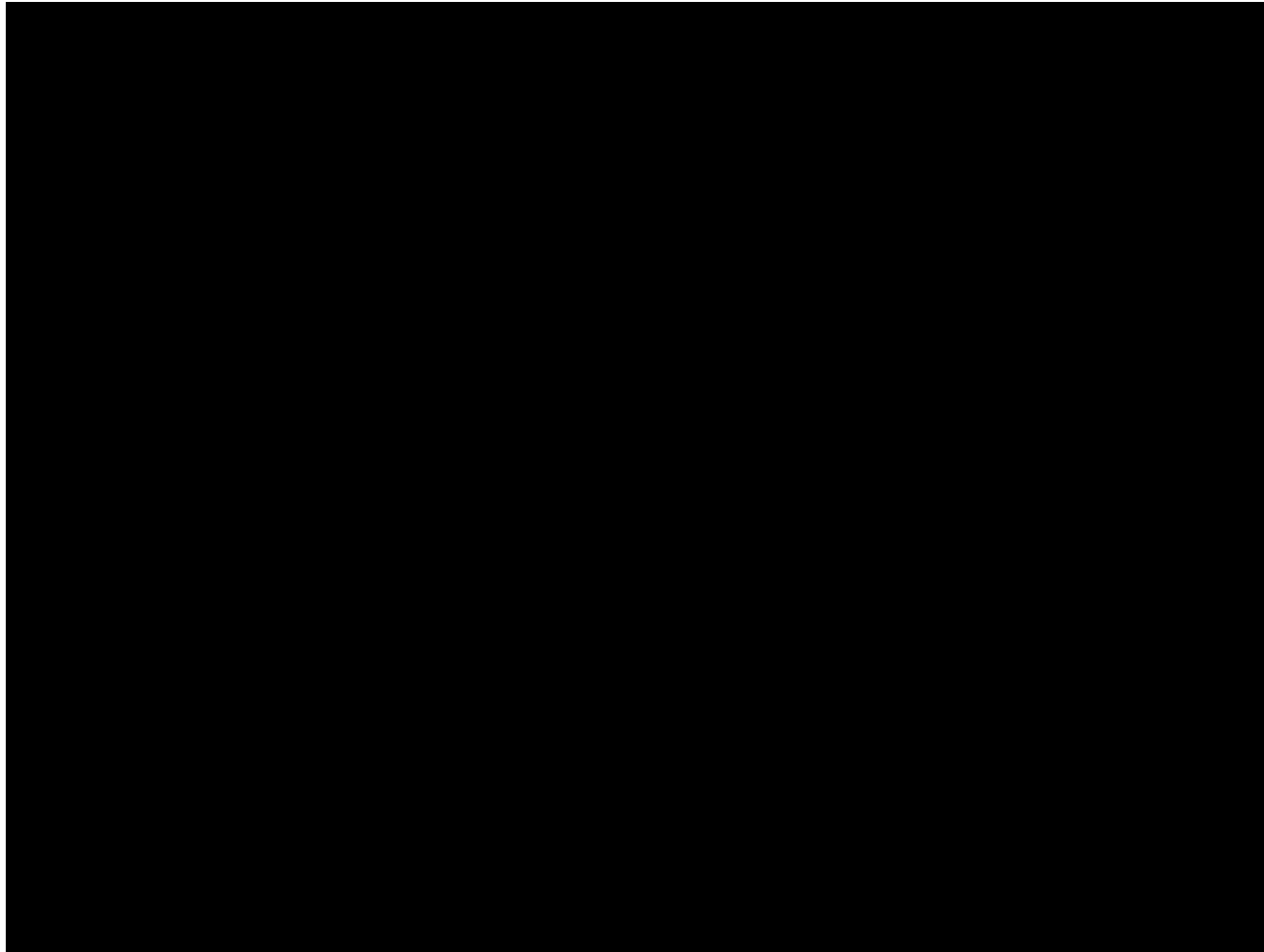
